

NOTIFICATION

In continuation of previous notification no. CE-Sectt/UG Exam-2020/113, dated 13 November 2020, of the University of Burdwan, it is further notified for information of all concerned that the detailed modalities of UG CBCS Semester II, Semester IV and Part II Examinations, 2020 for both regular and backlog candidates will be as follows:

1. As usual, full marks for Internal Assessment/Evaluation of each CC/GE/L₂-1/L₂-2 Course will be of 15 and for SEC Course the full marks of Internal Assessment/Evaluation will be of 10. **Like SEC, full marks of Internal Assessment/Evaluation of AECC-2 will be of 10 for this year only.**
The modalities of Internal Assessment/Evaluation will be the same as those stipulated by the University of Burdwan. It will mainly be based on online class test/seminar/assignment.
2. Following the spirit of UGC Guidelines dated 29 April, 2020 the period of lockdown may be treated as 'deemed to be attended' by all the students of Semester II and Semester IV, including the backlog candidates. All the colleges are, therefore, instructed to award each of their students, including the backlog candidates, full marks for attendance (C₃ Component), i.e., 5 out of 5.
In this context, it may also be noted that the college will conduct Internal Assessment / Evaluation of all the students of Semester II and Semester IV, including the backlog candidates.
3. In case of students of Part II, the college will provide Internal Assessments / Evaluations (Online Class Test / Test / Seminar / Assignments) marks to the University following the **Principle : 50% of full marks on both of theory and practical papers as the case may be.**
4. After completion of the enrolment process, all the affiliated colleges must submit the marks of Internal Assessment / Evaluation of all students (UG CBCS Semester II, Semester IV and Part II), including the backlog candidates, corresponding to the finalised list of Enrolled Candidates, to the University, in the prescribed format to be notified latter on.

Accurate submission of marks of all candidates, in all the specified papers is essential to avoid the generation of NC candidates in future.
